About This Guide


This guide provides the information necessary for installing Sage Inventory Requirements Planning.


Important Information

Read this guide completely before installing Sage Inventory Requirements Planning version 6.20.1.0.0. The Sage Inventory Requirements Planning 6.20.1.0.0 installation includes Sage Inventory Requirements Planning and Sage 100 Standard, Advanced or Premium modified programs. Before installing Sage Inventory Requirements Planning 6.20.1.0.0, install and register Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium 2020.

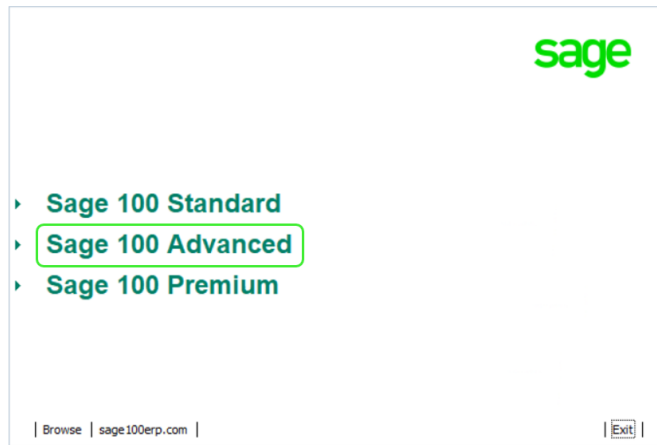

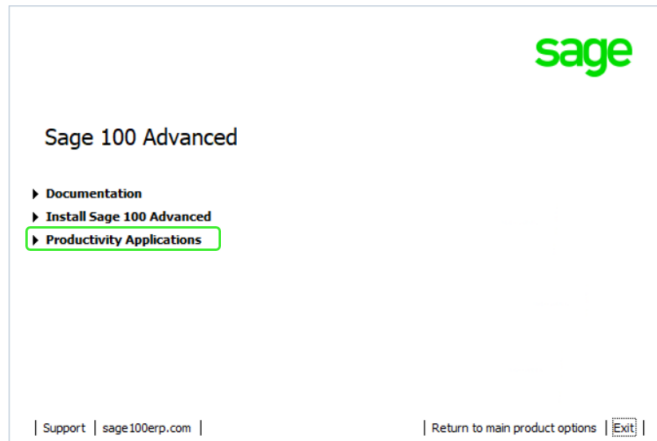
A new registration file is not required for service releases or product updates when a registration file was previously activated.

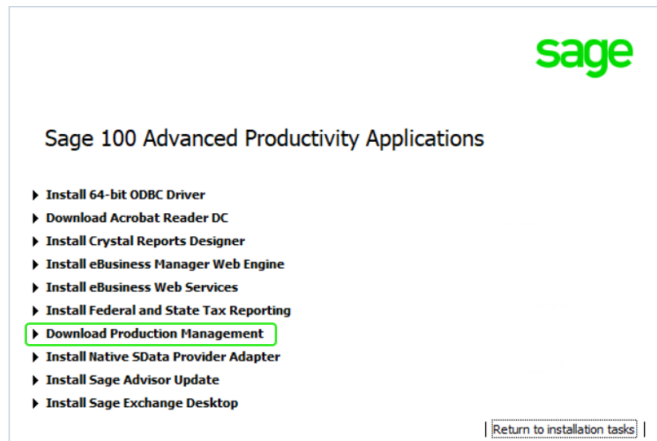
1. From the Sage 100 2020 installation Autorun screen, click a version of Sage 100.

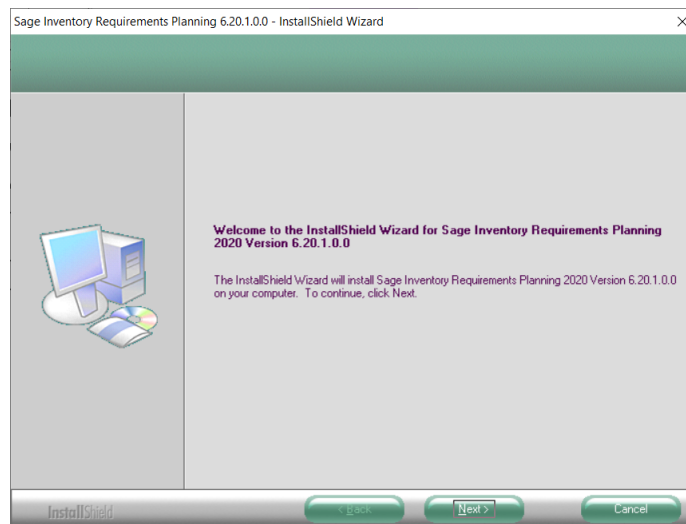

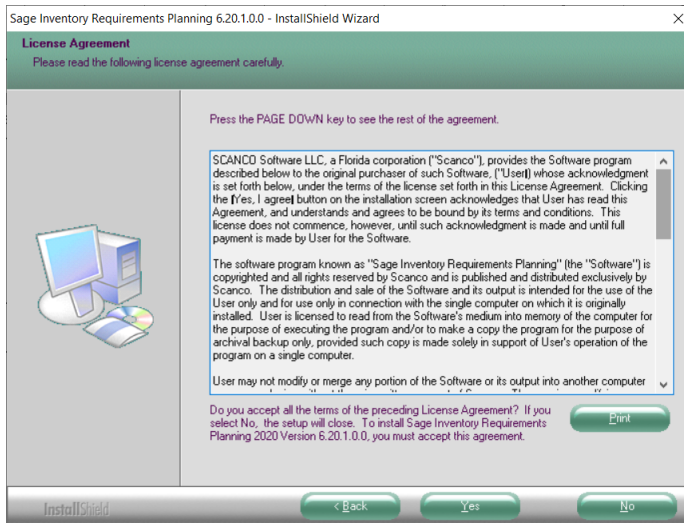

How to Install Sage Inventory Requirements Planning

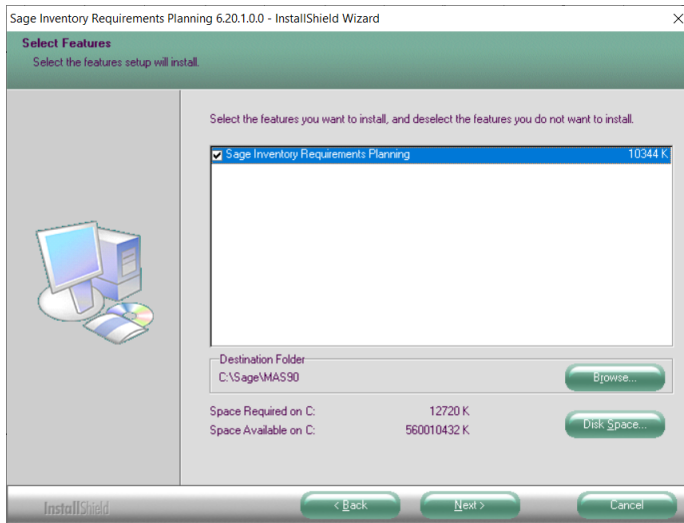
1. Download the IRP_2020_1_0.exe file from the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning Downloads page at <http://info.scanco.com/prod-mgmt-downloads>.
2. Right click on the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning 6.20.1.0.0 executable file.
3. Select Run as administrator.



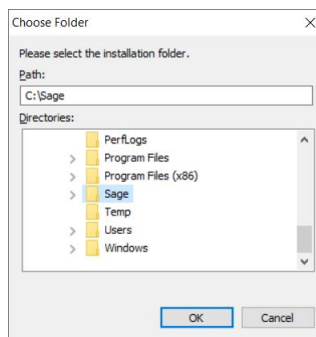
4. Select the Next button from the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning Welcome window.
5. Review the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning License Agreement.



6. Select the Yes button to agree to the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning License Agreement and to continue with the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning 6.20.1.0.0 installation process.
7. Select the Sage Inventory Requirements Planning check box to install Sage Inventory Requirements Planning 6.20.1.0.0.

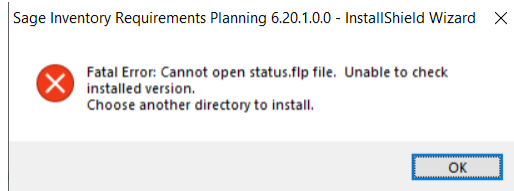


8. Accept the default location of Sage 100 or select the Browse button to specify the location of Sage 100. The Choose Folder window displays after the Browse button is selected.



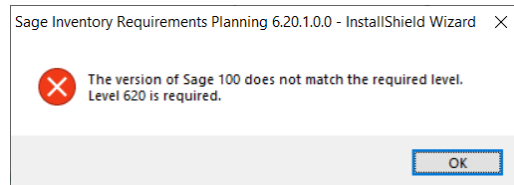
Specify the location of Sage 100 in the Path field. Select the OK button to return to the Select Features window.

Some Sage 100 modules are required to be installed to utilize Sage Inventory Requirements Planning. General Ledger, Common Information, and Inventory Management data files must be created prior to creating Sage Inventory Requirements Planning company data files. Purchase Order or Production Management data files must be created prior to creating Sage Inventory Requirements Planning company data files.

The following messages display when a Sage Inventory Requirements Planning task is accessed before company data files are created for the Sage 100 Purchase Order or Production Management module.
