

# Re: Scanco New Install: Dimex (WMS, Picking, MP2 & Mapadoc Integration)

Hi all,

The installation for Dimex's Scanco products is complete, pending two incomplete items. The outstanding items highlighted below that I need to make sure are taken care of, specifically the MP2 label design, but I have indeed confirmed that the firewall is working and is open, so that is a non-issue now.

## Completed Installation Checklist

The following items were completed on the MAS server for the Scanco installation:

- *Installation of Scanco WMS Barcode Module*
- *Installation of Scanco ConnectIt Service*
- *Licensure of Scanco WMS products for iOS devices for preauthorization of devices*
- *Test run of all above items to ensure completed*
- *Firewall was not open at install, can now confirm that it is working.*
- *Install of MP2 completed, label is **INCOMPLETE***
- *Install of Mapadoc integration added into SAGE, **PLEASE TEST MAPADOC FUNCTIONALITY TO CONFIRM SET UP***

### **Incomplete Item -- MP2 Label Design**

- **MP2 Label Specifications:**
  - **I provided an email after installation and I need some input to get your label design correct:**
    - **Needs:**
      - **Size**
      - **UDF (Fields) to display on barcode**
      - **What should be barcoded (usually ItemCode)**
    - **Note that cannot be centered fully on the label, it will be aligned left in most cases.**

- *The example was somewhat helpful, but there were not specifics identified on the label design example as to what you would like/need on the MP2 label.*

### **Incomplete Item -- Mapadoc Testing**

- *Scanco did install and added the necessary UDFs for the Mapadoc integration, but we were unable to add a business object reference to BC\_HeaderRejection for PrintLbls field as there was a Sage error for this. We did add the UDF manually but it is not linked to BC\_header.*
- *Please test the Mapadoc integration as this should be working aside from anything written to the rejections table.*

## **Warehouse 100 Setup**

The app setup is very simple. Once you have your iOS devices, make sure they are connected on wifi, on the same network as your MAS server. From here, all you need to do is the following:

- On each iOS device, install Scanco Warehouse 100 from the App Store.
- In the Settings menu on first open of the app, enter the INTERNAL IP ADDRESS of the MAS server (10.0.0.6) and press ENTER/RETURN on the keyboard.
- In the PORT area, make sure the port is set to 50000 and press ENTER/DONE.
- The app will restart, and then automatically authorize your Warehouse 100 scanning device.

I have set up in our Scanco Portal for 12 authorizations for your 12 licenses of Scanco Warehouse.

## **Scanco Credentials**

Below is some further information on your installation, and some information you will want to keep handy. Here are a few important credentials which I wanted to provide you with for the Scanco Warehouse program:

### **Customer Code**

DIMEX

### **Scanco Cloud Logins**

These credentials are used for the RDP Scanco Cloud App (which is a Remote Desktop version of the Warehouse product). They are not able to be utilized as a backup Warehouse app if firewall is closed.

USERNAME: DIMEX1-DIMEX12

Password: Boat2500

Domain: cloud

## **Scanco Warehouse 100**

Server: 10.0.0.6

Port: 50000

The first 12 devices will be preauthorized on Warehouse 100. The application for Warehouse 100 can be downloaded directly from the iOS App Store. Please note that the server for Warehouse 100 is the internal IP of the MAS/SAGE server.

## **Warehouse User Logins**

These are default user logins on either Warehouse 100 or Scanco Cloud. More can be added / edited. This will be covered in training.

## **The Scanco Customer Portal**

This is where you can go to customize and set up Warehouse users, profiles, authorize and deauthorize devices, etc. -- this will be covered in the training session Maggie is setting up with one of our senior technicians.

## **Scanco MP2**

The Scanco MP2 was installed. If any additional PCs need the installation file for the Scanco MP2 product, that can be downloaded

here: <https://www.dropbox.com/s/cy5ecg2b9d3qo9w/MP2.Setup.msi?dl=0>

The only setup that will need to take place on that PC is that it will need to be on the same network as the MAS/SAGE server, and when it is booted up, the Labels folder path and the ConnectIt Settings address will need to point to the MAS server. We definitely recommend saving all label designs in the MAS90/Labels folder for network sharing.
